

Post operative instructions for implant crowns

- 1. Avoid all hot food and beverages until the effect of anaesthetic has diminished
- 2. Be careful not to bite your cheek or lip whilst still numb
- 3. Once the anaesthetic wears off take note whether your teeth bite evenly. If this does not settle after a couple of days please call us to have the crown adjusted. "High spots "can cause sensitivity on biting

- 5. It is very important to have a soft diet for 6 weeks after the implant crown placement. This will encourage strong bone to grow around the implant.
- 6. Brushing and flossing on a daily basis is required. This stops the bone and gum supporting the implant from being destroyed
- 7 To increase the life of your implant you must maintain your hygiene visits every six months or as instructed by the hygienist
